Information for Donation-Related Questions

Tax Deductibility – The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Puget Sound Health Care System is owned and operated by VA which, in turn, is part of the executive branch of the United States Government. As a federal agency, VA is specifically authorized to accept gifts, devises and bequests to benefit Veteran patients. A contribution or gift to the United States Government is a deductible charitable contribution for the purposes of the Internal Revenue Code under section 115. This is a subsection in the same statute that allows deductions for charitable contributions to Section 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations.

Receipts for In-Kind Donations - VA Puget Sound does not issue receipts for in-kind donations, and we cannot list the monetary value - the burden of proof for the tax deductible monetary value is on the donor. The “thank you” correspondence we provide to you serves as your receipt.

Other Important Information – Voluntary Service is responsible for accepting, accounting for and acknowledging all donations made to benefit VA Puget Sound Veterans and their families. We cannot accept gifts intended for employees or direct employee benefit. Because Voluntary Service is the only department authorized to accept donations on behalf of VA Puget Sound, we ask that you coordinate your donation with us in advance.
